Enrollment

- Enrollment is continuous and on a first-come first-serve basis. Enrollment is confirmed only upon the receipt of your application form and the settlement of your full payment.
- For regular term enrollments, the first writing and vocab & comprehension assessment is free of charge. Subsequent assessments are priced at \$200 each.
- A non-refundable registration fee of \$350 will be charged for all new enrollments.

Tuition

- You are required to let us know at the time of payment if your child will be missing any of the classes. Tuition fees shall be pro-rated accordingly. Apart from situations stipulated under "Cancellation, Transfer and Refund" in our terms and conditions, we regret that no refunds will be granted for classes that have been paid for.

Makeup Class

Regular Program	 Makeup classes will be granted for missed classes with 24 hours' advance notice or if student is sick with the presentation of a doctor's note. Each student is awarded <u>TWO</u> make up classes for a term of 12 paid classes, <u>ONE</u> makeup class for 11 paid classes and none for a term of 10 or less paid classes. Makeup classes cannot be carried over to any subsequent term. Makeup classes are not transferable between students, modules or programs. Makeup classes are subject to availability and we will try our best to place your child in a class at the same level.
